

Summary

This advice letter filing requests authorization to implement a temporary surcharge to the water rates in Park's Service Area. Park is seeking a temporary surcharge of \$0.338 per Ccf for domestic metered customers for a 18-month period. The surcharge is designed to recover the combined under-collection recorded in the Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (WRAM) and the Modified Production Cost Balancing Account (MCBA). Park is also seeking recovery of the residual account balance remaining from the 2009 WRAM/MCBA surcharge that has expired. Park further requests recovery of the unamortized account balances from the active 2010 and 2011 WRAM/MCBA surcharges. This request is made pursuant to the Commission's direction in Decision 08-02-036, dated February 28, 2008 and Decision 12-04-048, dated April 19, 2012.

Background and Discussion

In D.08-02-036 the Commission adopted the Settlement Agreement between Park and the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) on WRAM and Conservation Rate Design Issues dated June 15, 2007. D.08-02-036 adopted a Trial Program for Park consisting of a conservation rate design and related mechanisms for decoupling sales and revenue (WRAM and MCBA). The Trial Program was implemented on September 15, 2008 with Commission approval of Park Advice Letter No. 200-W. In D.12-04-048 the Commission modified D.08-02-026 by authorizing an 18-month amortization schedule for the net balance recorded in the WRAM and MCBA. D.12-04-048 also authorized the recovery of account balances that have been under-amortized thus far while the surcharge has been in effect.

The purpose of the WRAM is to track the difference between adopted and actual commodity rate revenue excluding revenue for fire service, reclaimed water, and miscellaneous fees. The purpose of the MCBA is to track the difference between adopted and actual costs for the following variable costs: purchased water, purchased power, and pump tax. The MCBA captures variations in production costs due to either changes in unit price or changes in consumption.

The combined balance recorded in the WRAM and MCBA for the period January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012, including interest through February 28, 2013, is an under-collection of \$2,036,395.

Park filed an information-only report with the Division of Water and Audits for the amounts recorded in the WRAM and MCBA during calendar year 2012 on November 30, 2012 detailing the WRAM and MCBA data for nine months, ending September 30, 2012. As compared to the information-only report, this filing includes an updated twelve months of WRAM and MCBA data, ending December 31, 2012, with a total net under-collected balance of \$2,035,835. With interest through February 28, 2013, the under-collection is \$2,036,395.

Park filed Advice Letter 215-W-A on July 1, 2010 seeking recovery of the combined WRAM and MCBA balance as of December 31, 2009. Advice Letter 215-W-A was approved by the Commission on July 7, 2010 implementing a 24-month period surcharge. This surcharge is no longer in effect. With interest through February 2013, the total remaining under-collection or residual balance is \$356,798.

In addition to the net WRAM and MCBA balance for calendar year 2012 and the residual balance from the expired surcharge described above, Park proposes to include the under-amortized balances, as of February 28, 2013 from the active surcharges for the 2010 and 2011 WRAM/MCBA that are ongoing. Because the actual sales were lower than the adopted sales assumed for the surcharge calculation, Park did not recover the regulatory account balances as intended and authorized by the Commission. Therefore, pursuant to the procedure authorized in D.12-04-048, (Section 3.7 Treatment for Under-Amortized Amounts) Park is requesting to include with this filing the under-amortized balances for the active WRAM/MCBA surcharges including \$378,724 for the 2010 WRAM/MCBA and \$253,837 for the 2011 WRAM/MCBA, a combined total under-collection of \$632,561.

Park proposes to combine all the above balances for a total of \$3,025,754. Park is therefore requesting recovery of \$3,025,754 or 10.09% of its adopted 2012 revenue requirement. Park proposes to recover the under-collection recorded in the WRAM and MCBA through an 18-month surcharge of \$0.338 per Ccf applicable to domestic service for schedules PR-1-R, residential metered service and PR-1-NR, non-residential metered service.

The Commission Staff has been provided with workpapers developing the balances in the WRAM, MCBA, and the ICBA. The calculation of the surcharges is included in the workpapers.

Tier Designation

Pursuant to D.07-01-024, this advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

Requested Effective Date

Pursuant to General Rule 7.3.2 of General Order 96-B, Park requests this filing become effective on April 10, 2013.

Notice and Service

In accordance with General Order 96-B, General Rules 4.3 and 7.2 and Water Industry Rule 4.1, a copy of this advice letter will be mailed or electronically transmitted on April 27, 2012 to competing and adjacent utilities and other utilities or interested parties having requested such notification.

In accordance with Resolution W-4664, notice is not required. Park will include notice of the rate change within the bill during the first billing period the increase is in effect.

Response or Protest

Anyone may respond to or protest this advice letter. A response supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A protest objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the advice letter;
- (2) The relief requested in the advice letter would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the advice letter contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the advice letter is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the advice letter requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the advice letter process; or

(6) The relief requested in the advice letter is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require re-litigating a prior order of the Commission).

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

A response or protest must be made in writing or by electronic mail and must be received by the Division of Water and Audits within 20 days of the date this advice letter is filed. The address for mailing or delivering a protest is:
