As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.451 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 18-months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 268-W. This surcharge will recover the under-collection in the WRAM and MCBA as of December 31, 2015.
21. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, an amount of \$0.03 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rate for a period of 12 months, beginning on the effective date of Advice Letter 266-W. This surcharge will recover the net total under-collected balance for the Income Tax Repair Regulations Implementation Memorandum Account, the Low-Income Customer Data Sharing Cost Memorandum Account, the Credit Card Memorandum Account, and the Cost of Capital Memorandum Account.
22. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, a one-time sur-credit of \$4.60 (R) per customer is to be applied on the effective date of Advice Letter 269-W-A. This sur-credit will refund the over-collection in the Conservation Expense One-Way Conservation Balancing Account as of December 31, 2015. (R)
